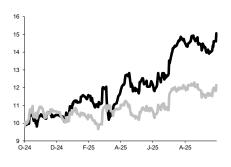

- 3Q25 sales results slightly ahead of expectations. Technogym has released its 9M25 sales results, which came in slightly above consensus expectations (Eu708.5mn vs. Eu698mn FactSet consensus and Eu697mn in our preview). Revenues grew +14% YoY (+15% at constant ForEx), confirming solid momentum across all channels and regions despite tougher comps and an adverse ForEx effect. The company reported continued double-digit growth in both B2B and B2C, consistent with the trends already seen in the first half of the year. Management reiterated confidence in the execution of its strategic plan but provided no incremental guidance or additional data beyond the press release.
- B2B continuing to outperform. The B2B division reached Eu567.9mn (+15.0% YoY), while B2C came in at Eu140.6mn (+10.1% YoY), both broadly in line with 1H trends. Growth remained well balanced across commercial sub-segments, with positive contributions from hospitality, corporate and health-related projects. The consumer business continued to benefit from retail expansion and brand strength, though management confirmed the limited size of the boutique network.
- **Growth broad based across regions.** Growth remained well balanced across all regions, with the Americas once again standing out as the key driver, up +23.6% YoY, showing further acceleration compared to 1H. The performance was broad-based, with both North and South America contributing and no large single project behind the growth. Europe (ex-Italy) continued to post a solid double-digit trend (+11.8% YoY), supported by good momentum in the hospitality, residential and health segments. Italy also performed strongly (+18.4% YoY), confirming the resilience of domestic demand. MEIA maintained its healthy pace of growth (+13.7% YoY), while APAC returned to positive mid-single-digit growth (+7.5% YoY), showing some improvement versus the first half but still lagging behind the Group's average.
- **Top line estimates:** we are revising revenues expectations upwards by 1.2% for FY25 and 1.1% for the following years considering actual 9M figures.
- NEUTRAL, target Eu14.5 (unchanged). We think TGYM offers an appealing mediumterm equity story thanks to its strong brand and leading positioning, attracting the interest of investors seeking exposure to the global wellness industry through a high-end player. The company is well placed to continue to deliver sustainable and profitable growth as confirmed by the resilience of the underlying business, while exploiting the increasingly significant macro trends that combine wellness and the health sector through its frontrunner status. For the last two quarters, results have exceeded our expectations to a remarkable extent, and we currently do not have enough visibility to factor in a further re-rating from current levels driven by estimates expansion for this year and next. We therefore confirm our NEUTRAL recommendation. The stock is trading at c.22x P/E26 and c.12x EV/EBITDA 26, a premium of c. 10% to the historical average, which in our opinion factors in current expectations for top line growth and margins to return to pre-Covid levels (FY19) in 2027, in line with our estimates.

- main methods used to evaluate financial instruments and set a target price for 12 months after the investment recommendation are as follows:
  Discounted cash flow (DCF) model or similar methods such as a dividend discount model (DDM)
  Comparison with market peers, using the most appropriate methods for the individual company analysed: among the main ratios used for industrial sectors are price/ earnings (P/E), EV/EBITDA, EV/EBIT, price /sales
- Return on capital and multiples of adjusted net book value are the main methods used for banking sector stocks, while for insurance sector stocks return on allocated capital and multiples on net book value and embedded portfolio value

For the utilities sector comparisons are made between expected returns and the return on the regulatory asset base (RAB)

Some of the parameters used in evaluations, such as the risk-free rate and risk premium, are the same for all companies covered, and are updated to reflect market conditions. Currently a risk-free rate of 4.0% and a risk premium between 5.5% - 6.0% are being used.
